# Day 1 Saturday, September 2: Depart USA

Depart Newark Liberty International Airport aboard United Airlines for our overnight flight to Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served in flight.

## Day 2 Sunday, September 3: Arrive in Rome

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and we will be on our way to our hotel in Rome. As it is unlikely our rooms will be ready, we'll drop luggage at our hotel.

Enjoy an introduction to the "Eternal City" on a Golf Cart Tour to the Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps and more! We will stop along the way for an independent lunch and gelato.

After our orientation tour we'll continue to Hotel Kolbe in Rome for check-in. Freshen up for Mass followed by dinner at the hotel.

Vespers and Sunday Mass will be celebrated at St. Maximilian Kolbe Chapel. Pilgrim meeting (subject to meeting space availability).

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

## Day 3 Monday, September 4: Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica

Lauds at the Kolbe Chapel followed by breakfast at our hotel. Transfer to St. Peter's Basilica to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto chapels. After Mass we'll have a tour of St. Peter's Basilica with time to pray before the tombs of St. John Paul II, St. Paul VI, St. John XXIII, and Pope Benedict XVI. Independent lunch at Vatican Museums. Together we will explore and appreciate the breathtaking Sistine Chapel, decorated with some of the most beautiful frescoes ever made. Enjoy time on your own to visit the richly decorated galleries of the Vatican Museums. Continue on by bus to the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome and the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces.

Vespers, dinner at hotel, and Pilgrim meeting (subject to meeting space availability).

# Day 4 Tuesday, September 5: Basilicas of Rome

Lauds at the Kolbe Chapel followed by breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with Mass at the Basilica of St. John Lateran followed by a tour of the Basilica and visit to the Holy Stairs (Scala Sancta). Time will be given for pilgrims to ascend the Holy Stairs on their knees in prayer. From here we we'll walk to Santa Croce with a stop for pastries along the way. Our visit to Church of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme will include veneration of relics of the True Cross. Tradition says that St. Helen brought to Rome, after her pilgrimage, the fragments of the True Cross and one of the nails used in the Crucifixion of Our Lord. A boxed lunch will be provided.

Continuing on by bus, we will visit the Basilicas of St. Mary Major and St. Paul Outisde the-Walls. We will have a guided visit of St. Paul's, ending with Vespers. Return to the hotel for dinner. After dinner, we'll take an evening walk to the Capitol building and Piazza del Campidoglio.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome.

# Day 5 Wednesday, September 6: Papal Audience | Scavi Tour

Lauds at the Kolbe Chapel followed by breakfast at our hotel. Enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

Scavi Tour (Tours of the Scavi are one hour long and limited to 12-15 persons.) The Scavi, or Vatican Necropolis, is the underground excavation under St. Peter's Basilica. In 1939, Pope Pius XII ordered an excavation beneath the grotto of St. Peter's Basilica, where many popes are buried. Among the tombs of pagans and early Christians, far beneath the high altar of St. Peter's, excavators found a shrine amid the rubble. Most scholars concur that the small column is part of a secondcentury A.D. shrine built by Rome's small Christian community on the site where St. Peter was buried.

# Day 6 Thursday, September 7: Castle Gandolfo

Lauds at the Kolbe Chapel followed by breakfast at our hotel. We will travel to Castelli Romani for a visit of Castel Gandolfo, the summer residence of the Pope. Enjoy the attractive hilltop town dominated by the Papal Palace and the extensive gardens. We'll take a private tour of the gardens, Vatican Observatory, and Papal Museum. Mass at Chiesa di San Tommaso da Villanova.

Enjoy a wine tasting of the region and festive meal at Tenuta Santa Benedetta.

Experience an atmosphere of hospitality, friendship, and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting. Return to the hotel.

Vespers and Pilgrim Meeting (subject to meeting space availability) Overnight at our hotel in Rome.

# Day 7 Friday, September 8: Rome | Greccio | Assisi

Lauds at the Kolbe Chapel followed by breakfast at our hotel. Check-out of Hotel Kolbe and board our private touring bus for our journey to Assisi. Along the way we will stop to visit Fonte Columba and Greccio, where we will celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Shrine of Greccio. A boxed lunch will be provided.

Arrival and settle in at Casa del Terzario (religious guesthouse)

Meet with FSE Sisters for an overview of the days in Assisi. Introductory walk to visit the Main Square, Roman sites, places important to St. Francis and St. Clare's youth: Chiesa Nuova, the family house of Francis, and Sanctuary of the Spoliation/Blessed Carlo Acutis.

Vespers and dinner at the guesthouse. Overnight at the guesthouse in Assisi.

# Day 8 Saturday, September 9: Sites of St. Francis and St. Clare

Lauds and breakfast at the guesthouse. Following breakfast, we will walk to the Basilica of St. Francis and celebrate Mass, followed by a guided tour. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare for a guided tour.

Independent lunch and free time. Later this afternoon, we will visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, which houses the shrine of the "Porziuncola" or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered. After our visit we'll go to a local restaurant for dinner.

# After dinner, return to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels to participate in

the Rosary and torchlight procession. Return to the guesthouse. Overnight at the guesthouse in Assisi.

# Day 9 Sunday, September 10: LaVerna

Lauds followed by breakfast at the guesthouse. Depart Assisi for an excursion to LaVerna. In the summer of 1224, St. Francis withdrew on the mountain for his ordinary spiritual exercises and silence. During his stay, he asked God to be able to take part, from the very deep of his heart, of the Passion of Christ, mystery of both love and pain. Here, 'Francis' turned into a visible and concrete image of Christ, not only in his heart, mind and soul, which already were, but even in his exterior body. The Stigmata episode together with Francis' lifestyle are the most precious things given to his friars at La Verna. Celebrate Mass at LaVerna.

Independent lunch at the sanctuary. After lunch, return to Assisi. The remainder of the afternoon is free for rest, shopping, and personal prayer.

**Vespers** and Final Meeting (subject to meeting space availability) Dinner and overnight at the guesthouse in Assisi.

# Day 10 Monday, September 11: San Damiano | Eremo delle Carceri

Lauds followed by breakfast at the guesthouse. Today we will visit the Sanctuary of San Damiano, where we will reflect on moments and themes in the life of St. Francis such as kissing the leper, his prayer before the crucifix, rebuilding the church, Clare and community, and Canticle of the Creatures. Continue to the Hermitage of the Carceri, where St. Francis and his followers prayed and meditated on Mount Subasio. Celebrate Mass. Independent lunch at the sanctuary. Return to Assisi

Free time for rest, prayer, shopping, and packing due to a very early departure on Tuesday. Afternoon visit to the Franciscan Sisters of the Eucharist House with Vespers and pilgrim meeting. Farewell dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at the guesthouse in Assisi. (B,D)

# Day 11 Tuesday, September 12: Return to the USA

Very early morning, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in 2023, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from Newark. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase subject to ticketing. If you purchase independent connecting flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.

The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150.00 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. **TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at the hotel in Rome is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested; with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$850.00 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

**MEALS:** Breakfast daily, two (2) boxed lunches, six (6) hotel dinners, a festive dinner with wine tasting at Tenuta Santa Benedetta in Rome and two (2) restaurant dinners in Assisi.

If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions. The insurance plan can be purchased at any time thereafter, excluding coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made. All plan payments are non-refundable. You can cancel up to 2 days prior to departure and receive reimbursement of up to 80% of the non-refundable payments for your trip. Once you begin your trip, coverage under the plan will end as soon as you go back to your return destination. This means that if you return home early, your coverage will terminate early as well.
